Just a quick note from the kitchen, first thing is the kitchen staff would like to take this opportunity to thank all of our members for a very successful summer season. With all the challenges we faced with product, staffing, hot weather, we managed to have one of the best season the club has ever had and this is due to the tremendous member support. So, from everybody in the kitchen, Thank You.

Curried pumpkin soup with chicken

- 1 tbsp peanut oil
- 5 cups Diced Butternut Pumpkin
- 1/3 cup (100g) korma curry paste
- 3 cups (750ml) chicken stock
- 270ml coconut cream
- 1 cup (160g) shredded Chicken Breast
- 100g green beans, trimmed, halved crossways
- 1/2 cup (140g) Greek-style yoghurt
- 1 long green chilli, sliced (optional)
- 1/4 cup (20g) Shredded Coconut, toasted
 - 2 tbsp chopped chives

Step 1: Heat the oil in a large saucepan over medium-high heat. Add the pumpkin and cook for 2 mins. Add curry paste. Cook for 30 secs or until fragrant.

Step 2: Add stock to the pan. Bring to the boil. Reduce heat to medium. Simmer for 5 mins or until pumpkin is tender. Remove from heat. Cool slightly. Use a stick blender to blend until smooth.

Step 3: Add coconut cream and place over medium heat. Bring to a simmer. Add chicken and beans. Cook for 2 mins or until beans are bright green and tender.

Step 4: Divide soup among serving bowls. Top with the yoghurt. Sprinkle with chilli, if using, coconut and chives.
