STACKING RINGS | 9AM-12PM | \$85

In this class you will be making three sterling silver rings. You will learn the basics of fusing, soldering and setting small cabochons. A selection of semi-precious stones and hand-made sterling decorations will be available for your design. You will measure, cut, fuse and add texture to your bands. How to use the jeweler's torch safely will be demonstrated, then you will do the soldering under supervision. Next, we set your chosen stones and do the final polish to your creations. TaDa! You have completed a trio of unique stacking rings! Skill level: beginner/novice (2.5-3 hours)



BRAIDED SILVER RING | 1PM-4PM | \$85

Learning to braid with eight strands is easy, once you know how. First, we will learn with string, then move up to fine silver. The ends can be finished for an adjustable or fitted ring.
